Principal's Desk

Mayang Anchalik College was established on August 13, 1992 to open up the doors of higher education to the economically and educationally backward Mayang region of Morigaon district of Assam.

The founding fathers of Mayang Anchalik College nurtured a dream for the upcoming generations of Assam in general and Mayang in particular; they considered the preservation of traditional humanitarian and ethical values, enhancement of literacy, intellectual and all-round development of society as their primary goals and objectives. They hoped to attain such a philanthropic end by means of higher education through the establishment of Mayang Anchalik College.

At present, the College is offering TDC courses in the Arts stream under the University of Gauhati. The University has adopted a new educational policy and introduced CBCS (Choice Based Credit System) from this year, which will help the students in further developing their studies and move on to the national as well as international level. Keeping with the requirement of higher education, Mayang Anchalik College is gearing up for the vocational, entrepreneurship and self sustaining courses with better job orientation. Recently the college has introduced a skill development centre at its own campus and has taken initiative to organize various training programmes for skill development. Till now, two residential training programmes on Jacquard Handloom have been successfully completed by the college in association with Indian Institute of Entrepreneurship, Guwahati for the session 2019-20. The college has also joined in Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievement (ARIIA) and National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) for the year 2020.
